



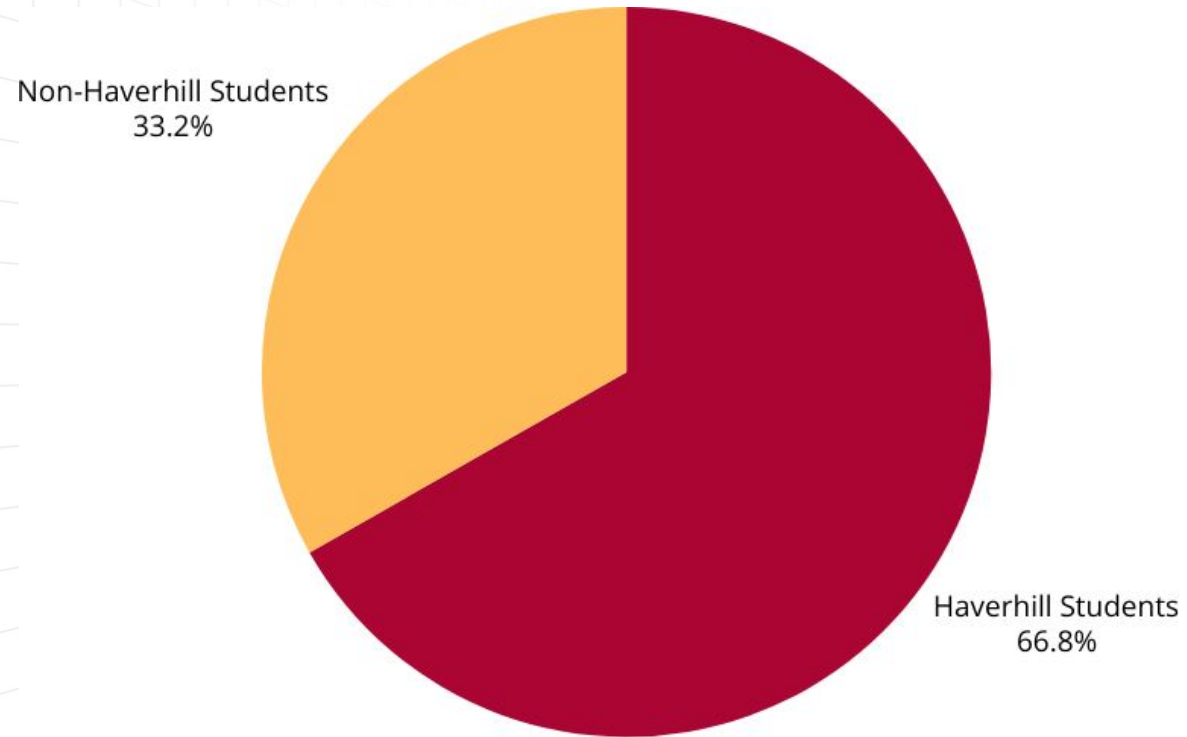

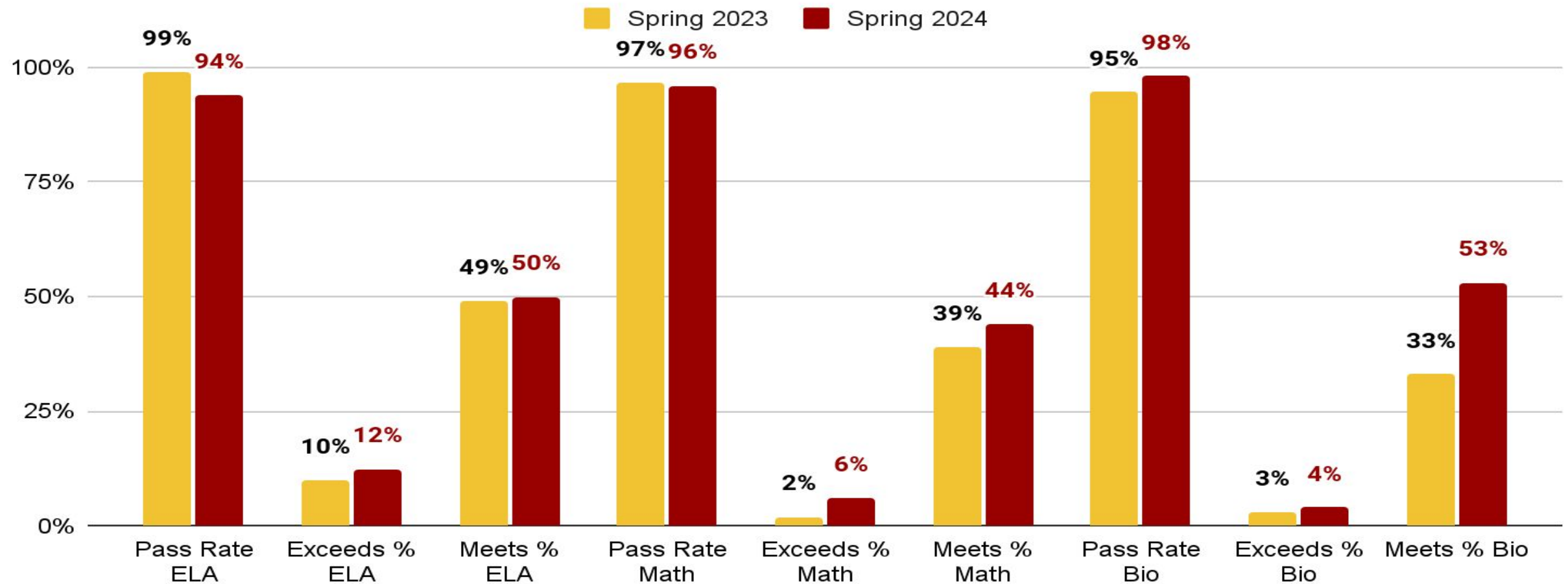

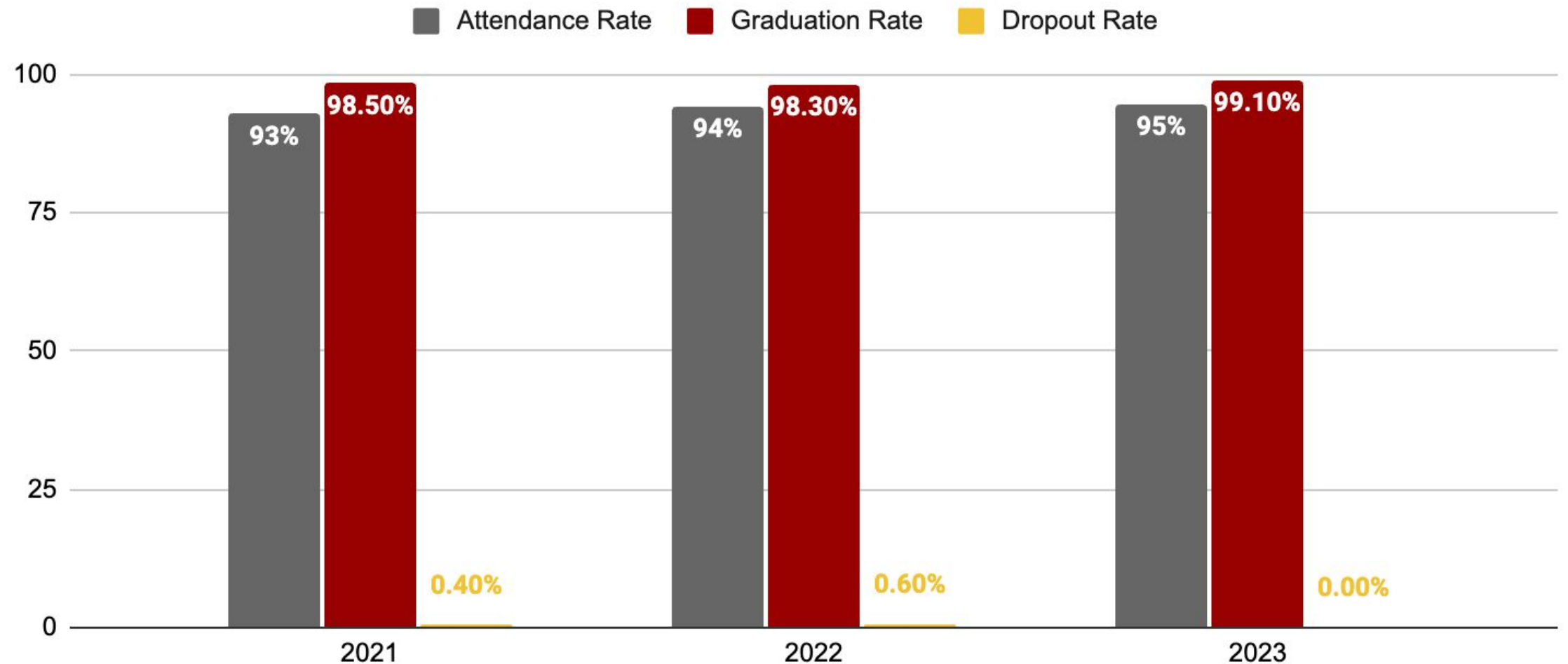
Whittier Tech Spring MCAS Data 2023 vs
